## A LETTER FROM OUR FOUNDER AND CEO RICK RICCARDI



Dear Friends,

I am immensely proud of our Organization for its 2019 operational achievements. Our COO, Directors and Staff have been outstanding.

To highlight some of our accomplishments, let us start with our new Respite Operation. The 20-bed facility accommodated 1,213 men and women who had a reoccurrence of use from alcohol or drugs with no other safe place to go. I am proud that we can provide our lifesaving recovery support services to this vulnerable population. This new initiative has the full support from our managing entity Broward Behavioral Health Coalition (BBHC), this relationship is a major development for the future of our organization.

We had over 500 new recovery residents this year. The average length of their stay was 6 months.

Our new Delray Beach Recovery Residence became fully operational with 28 male beds.

Our Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) Housing Program became fully operational and our standards have proven to be remarkably successful.

We measure ourselves by the recovery support services we provide and the connections to outside resources for our residents (see chart below). The development and implementation of these resources has been exceptional this year.

# **About Us**

Fellowship Foundation RCO and Fellowship Living Facilities Inc. are both 501 (c)(3) non-profit corporations structured and staffed to help individuals suffering from substance use disorder. Over the last 13 years we have grown from the original 20 residents recovery house to a recovery community of 240 men and women residents receiving peer recovery support services, which includes housing for those on Medication Assisted Treatment (M.A.T.).

We are a Recovery Oriented System of Care (ROSC) organization. Our focus is to meet the needs of those in recovery and remove any barriers to continued recovery through peer to peer support, housing, education, advocacy, and service.

Our hope is that by building a strong community of those in recovery we can remove the stigma associated with addiction, thereby allowing more individuals to raise their hand for help when needed.

Through our community center and our recovery residences located in Margate and Ft. Lauderdale we have worked with over 19,000 individuals to provide housing, develop life skills, create jobs, offer recovery capital training, and a foundation for recovery.

Our community center provides Life Skills classes and a Back 2 Work Program. The full-time staff at our center also provides training and CEU's to recovery professionals and those looking to begin a career in recovery.

We host meetings including family support groups, AA, NA, CA, Family Support Groups, Adult Children of Alcoholics, and music therapy.

To meet the social needs of individuals, there are a variety of fun events held which include our Recovery Music Café on Saturday nights. This is an opportunity for individuals to socialize in an environment free from drugs and alcohol with likeminded individuals.

Our nutritionist provided services to over 300 of our residents at no-cost. We currently have 30 to 45 individuals actively involved in this program per month. We've also found that many new in recovery have neglected their physical and emotional health while active in their addiction. We partner with many different agencies get our residents back on track in all these vital health areas.

Individuals contacting us are provided with information on resources available in the community. Information requests vary from how to get a state ID when there is not a permanent address to what types of recovery pathways are available.

# About the Recovery Community Respite

The Recovery Community Respite offers a Temporary Sober Housing environment for those who have relapsed, are waiting for transitional living, or in transit to a court ordered program. 2019 produced a staggering 84.6% successful program completion.

One Thousand Two Hundred Thirteen lives were saved in 2019. Clients were provided with a safe place to stay, with 3 meals per day, various therapeutic groups, support meetings, clothing, and also got connected with a variety of resources to aid each and every one of them through their recovery journey.

Fellowship Living Facilities has been providing a safe, structured, and supportive environment for over 5000 men and women in recovery since opening its doors in 2005. It offers a wide variety of Recovery Support Services, which are designed to assist men and women who are in recovery achieve their goals. Once the resident makes a commitment to overcome their addiction to drugs and alcohol, he or she will be on the road to achieve Positive Recovery outcomes.

### Weekly Program Reviews

Residents meet one on one with their assigned Sober Living Residence Manager on a weekly basis, and discuss their progress, meeting attendance, challenges experienced, and ways to resolve those challenges in a confidential setting.

### Social Skills Development

Communication skills are the key to developing (and keeping) friendships and to building a strong social support network. They also help you take care of your own needs, while being respectful of the needs of others. People aren't born with good communication skills; like any other skill, they are learned through trial and error and repeated practice.

#### **Measurable Recovery Outcomes**

Fellowship Living staff utilizes the cutting edge A.R.M.S. platform that measures the progress of all residents. The platform allows staff to provide Recovery Navigational Support in order to assist residents and fulfill their unmet needs.

### **Medication Assisted Treatment (M.A.T.) Housing**

Fellowship Living Facilities provides specialized housing to residents who are following a medication assisted treatment plan of care that is directed by a licensed healthcare provider.


